Hello Emily,

1) Since my last email I finally received the KRMC disclosures, but I have not heard from you. Did your 26.1 disclosures get lost in my email?

2) Since last Thursday I've been trying to get severely disabled Elliot titled. I chronicled my efforts and research at

I spent all day Facebook messaging and calling, only to ultimately be refused assistance or hung up on at KRMC, Mohave Mental Health, the County Attorney, the Prescott AZ AG's office and the Phoenix AG's

office.

Eventually, I was referred to your client Southwest and I quickly made the 130 mile round trip as they required me to personally deliver the application.

It did not go well, but at least they didn't incarcerate me again.

Southwest claimed that they wouldn't be able to find Elliot and that they cannot have Elliot picked up unless I have his full name, birth date, etc. etc. That is of course ludicrous. I asked them to contact the Sheriff's Office for more info about Elliot and his location, they refused.

I have been dealing with 33rd degree imbeciles for a week!

On my application I state that he is on Stockton Hill Road by mile marker 15 and near Calle Lucero. I checked on my way home and coming from Kingman, he is actually right past Ferguson Ranch Rd in the wash on the east side of Stockton Hill Rd, a few hundred feet before MM 15. Calle Lucero is the next street. His old camp on the west side in my pictures got washed away in a flashflood today.

Eventually, because I insisted on written documentation of their refusal to accept my application, they decided to keep my application and told me a nurse would decide.

I called Southwest after I got home over an hour later to inquire whether they had finally picked up Elliot, but I was told that the nurse was with a patient and she would call me. That was at 8 pm, now it is almost 2 am!

I have no desire to deal with these idiots any longer and probably shouldn't be contacting them directly since you are representing Southwest.

So I'll greatly appreciate it if you could let me know by noon tomorrow whether they picked up Elliot. If not, I'll have to continue to try to get help for Elliot somehow before he dies in the desert like the man they found on 7/23.

Attached are a map and my application.

3) I'm hoping that you will have good news for me tomorrow and that I can finally start working on my response to your motion instead of working on getting help for Elliot. I hope you don't mind if I file my response on Monday.
